

Here is the financial summary for the month of March, 2023.

This month we had a net income of \$632, greater than the budget by \$963. Operating Revenue was much improved to \$23,207, greater than budget by \$2,046. However, revenue was greatly enhanced by receiving two individuals annual pledges totaling \$8,288 and special offerings of Earthquake Disaster Relief, \$1,800 and One Great Hour of Sharing, \$712.

Operating Expenses were \$22,575 greater than the budget by \$1,083. However, expenses included the pass through to the Conference of the special offerings noted above totaling \$2,512.

The Building and Expanded Ministry Fund is \$190,044. This reflects a regular increase of \$3,178 which includes an annual pledge of \$1,300.

There were no other revenue or expense items that were not normal budget activity.



Come join us... Mission & Caring meets on the second Tuesday of each month in the fellowship hall at 6 p.m.






The month of May will be the second collection for the Festival of Sharing mission project. The first collection was in
