



The financial summary for the month of June, 2023.

This month we had an operating loss of (\$208), favorable to budget by \$2,266. Operating revenue was again very strong this month at \$17,699, unfavorable to budget by (\$3,462).

Operating expenses were \$17,907, favorable to the budget by \$5,728. As noted last month, our quarterly insurance premium was paid last month while it was included in this month's budget.

If that payment of \$3,420 had been made in June, we would only have been favorable \$2,308.

The Building and Expanded Ministry Fund is \$194,128. This reflects the regular increase of \$1,328.

There were no other revenue or expense items that were not normal budget activity
